Dear Authorized Representative and Fiscal Contact for the Town of Irvington:

The Town of Irvington is entitled to receive \$152,766.76 under the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund's Non-Entitlement Unit (NEU) distribution*. This funding will be distributed in two tranches: **the first tranche (approximately half) has been distributed to the Town of Irvington on June 30, 2021 in the amount of \$76,383.38 via ACH** and the second tranche (approximately half) will be distributed in approximately 12 months, per Federal guidelines. You will receive another communication when the second tranche is distributed.

The following formula was mandated by U.S. Department of the Treasury (Treasury), and used by the Commonwealth to calculate the amount of NEU funds to distribute to your entity:

Total population of the NEU × Aggregate state NEU payment* Total population of all eligible NEUs

*The Commonwealth is required to allocate and distribute the Local Fiscal Recovery Fund payment received from Treasury to each NFU in the Commonwealth an amount that bears the same proportion to the amount of such payment as the population of the NEU bears to the total population of all the NEUs in the State. However, the total amount to be distributed to an NEU may not exceed the amount equal to 75 percent of its most recent budget as of January 27, 2020. **Under the interim final rule, the total allocation and distribution to an NEU, including the sum of both the first and second tranches of funding, cannot exceed the 75 percent cap.**

The Commonwealth does not provide legal counsel to local governments on the permissible use of NEU funds; therefore, the Town of Irvington must review official Treasury guidance and determine permissible use.
